MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

CyberPeace Corps Initiative
B-55, MIG Bhirsa Munda Rajpat
Harmu Housing Colony
Ranchi, Jharkhand-834002
(Hereinafter referred to as "CPC")

And

Gossner College
Gossner College, Ranchi Niral Enem Horo Marg,
Ranchi- 834001 (Jharkhand), India
(Hereinafter referred to as the "Gossner College")
Collectively referred to as the "Parties."

Preamble:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes a cooperative agreement between CPC and Gossner College to promote cybersecurity awareness, knowledge exchange, and the active engagement of students and faculty in CyberPeace initiatives.

Objective:

The Parties agree to collaborate in areas of mutual interest pertaining to the global cybersecurity landscape, training, research, and community engagement.

Areas of Collaboration:

The parties hereby agree to establish the following collaborations and activities, including but not limited to:

- Awareness Campaigns: Organizing seminars, workshops, and events related to cybersecurity.
- Training Programs: Facilitating courses, certifications, and skill-building exercises for students and faculty.
- Research: Joint research projects, publications, and academic endeavours.
- Community Engagement: Mobilizing student volunteers for cyber peace projects, drives, and community initiatives.
- Resource Sharing: Mutual sharing of academic materials, tools, and infrastructure.
- CyberPeace Club: Additionally, both parties also intend to establish a 'CyberPeace Club', which shall serve as a platform for students and faculty members to actively engage in cybersecurity awareness, advocacy, and community service initiatives under the guidance and support from CPC. The CyberPeace Clubs will serve as a local hub for advocacy, education, and community engagement, focusing on the development of cyber resilience and ethical digital citizenship.



Responsibilities:

CPC shall:

- Provide expert resources, trainers, and speakers for events.
- Collaborate on research and publications.
- Assist in setting up cybersecurity labs or centers within the Institution.

The Gossner College shall:

- Facilitate the organization of events, workshops, and seminars.
- Encourage student and faculty participation in CPC projects.
- Provide logistical support and infrastructure as required.
- Assist and collaborate regarding establishing 'CyberPeace Club'.

Terms and Duration:

This MoU will be in effect for a duration of five years, commencing from 01st April 2024. This MoU can be extended or amended only by written instrument between both the Parties.

Termination:

Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing a 45-day written notice. In the case of termination, all ongoing projects will be brought to a suitable conclusion as determined by both Parties.

Force Majeure

Neither Party shall be liable to the other Party in respect of anything which, apart from this provision, may constitute breach of this MoU arising by reason of circumstances beyond the control of the either Party, which shall include but shall not be limited to acts of God, fire, flood, drought, explosion, sabotage, accident, embargo, riot, war, civil commotion, or civil authority, including acts of local government and parliamentary authority.

Confidentiality

During the term of this MoU, each Party may disclose to the other its confidential information. The receiving Party shall hold such confidential information in strict confidence for the disclosing Party and shall not use it except in furtherance of the relationship set forth in this MoU, or except as may be authorized by the disclosing Party in writing.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR):

The Intellectual Property (IP) of any material, content, report or any other info protected under IP shared by either Party during the collaborative initiatives under this MoU will remain the property of the Part who are its concerned owners, respectively.

The material, content and any other IP shared during by either side is strictly for the purposes of the collaborative initiative under this MoU and cannot be used by either party

outside the scope of this MoU. Any IP generated as part of the collaboration under this MoU will be treated as joint IP or as agreed from time to time on a case-to-case basis.

Both Parties shall do everything in their capability to safeguard and protect the IP of each other from external entities.

Governing Law And Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MoU, Parties shall initially attempt in good faith, to resolve the dispute through negotiations between the senior executives of the Parties.


